


WHY WE'RE STILL STANDING OUT HERE IN 2016

This vigil for peace and justice has been held here every Sunday from 12 until 1 p.m. since May of 1999.

Often people ask us what we mean when we say, “RESIST THIS ENDLESS WAR.” What we mean is that the serial wars waged by the U.S. and its allies are actually one war being waged on many fronts. Men, women and children are being slaughtered, maimed, traumatized, driven from their homes all over the world so that immense wealth and power can be concentrated in the hands of a very few people.

The weapons of this war are many. Here are a few examples: drone attacks against targets 1000s of miles away (cowardly warfare by remote control); the persecution and deportation of immigrants and refugees; the systematic dismantling of an infrastructure and social programs that we depend upon and fund with our taxes; the destruction of labor unions and the refusal to offer a minimum wage that is a living wage.

We stand here to physically demonstrate our resistance to this war.
