## American Collusion in Israel/Palestine

A century ago, the US turned away refugee Jews needing asylum from persecution, forcing them to Palestine, a land occupied and colonized by Britain. The US protected neither Jews nor the Palestinians whose land was now taken over. After WWII, guilty for the horrors of the Holocaust, the US promoted division of Palestine into Jewish and Palestinian sections allowing the migrant Jews to take 55% of the land, which they immediately expanded to 80% without the US or UN trying to protect Palestinians from being driven out of their own country.

The US then stood by as Israel forcibly seized the remaining part of Palestine in the 1967 war. Then it stood by while colonial settlers, illegal under international law, continue to drive out Palestinians, killing them, destoying their trees and farms, denying them water and trade. There are no protections for non-Jews under Israeli law.

US legislators refuse even to intervene to protect Palestinian children from Israeli soldiers who break into homes in the middle of the night, kidnap the children and take them for unsupervised interrogation and torture by the military. Israeli civil law applies only to Jews.

The US sends more money to fund the Israeli military than to any other country, even after Israel became one of the most powerful militaries in the world and even though Palestinians are killed and maimed in far greater numbers than Israelis. (see charts on reverse side)




The US stood by while Palestinian East Jerusalem was taken over and Jerusalem made the capital of a state foreign to Palestinians. It stood by while the sovereign territory of Syria (the Golan) was annexed. Now Netanyahu plans to annex (not just occupy) the West Bank if reelected. No doubt the US will do nothing to stop him: American efforts to protect people's rights don't extend to all peoples but only a few. American money and political cover has protected Israel through decades of flagrant violations of law that in other countries would be punished by sanctions or even military invasion. The US ignores oppression of dissident Jews, human rights workers and non-Jews (Christians, Muslims, Bedouin, Druze) in Israel, stops accurate information from reaching Americans, suppresses peaceful movements for change, and smears with charges of antisemitisim anyone who tries to help.


