

No more US money and bombs for the Netanyahu government's slaughter in Gaza.

The United States government is not merely “complicit” in this murder of innocent civilians. Without U.S. money, weapons, and political support, it would never have been possible.

Since October 2023, the U.S. has given more than \$30 billion in taxpayer-funded weapons to enable the atrocities of Netanyahu’s government. The official death toll alone (more than 60,000 Palestinians in Gaza) is a vast undercount of the dead. And it does not include the hundreds of thousands seriously wounded or the people (mostly children) now dying from famine. With the support of the Trump administration and the majority in Congress, the Netanyahu government continues to escalate its ethnic cleansing campaign by killing and starving the people of Gaza and driving them from their homes.

Two things that you can do immediately

1. **Contact your Representatives to support H.R. 3565**, a bill to “block the bombs” that has already been introduced in the House of Representatives. Go to <https://action.ccrjustice.org/a/email-congress-block-the-bombs-to-israel-hr3565> to sign an online letter. Then, please also call and write your representative at their office directly.

For Connecticut’s 3rd district, which includes New Haven, the Congress member is Rep. Rosa DeLauro. Call her at (203) 562-3718; send her an email through the online form at https://delauro.house.gov/zip_authentication?form=/contact/email; and also send a hand-written letter (very effective) to her at her New Haven office, 59 Elm Street, New Haven CT 06510, and her DC office at 2413 Rayburn House Office Building Washington, DC 20515. 2. **Contact your Senators** to introduce a companion bill to “block the bombs” **in the Senate**. 13 Senators most likely to

act on this are being approached to introduce such a bill to mirror H.R. 3565. **Sen. Chris Murphy from Connecticut is one of them.** Go here to view the draft letter and to sign it **by tomorrow, September 15th**:

Murphy directly via email at <https://www.murphy.senate.gov/contact>, followed by phone calls to his offices in Hartford (860) 549-8463 and in DC at (202) 224-4041 Also, you can send a hand-written letter to his offices in Hartford at Colt Gateway, 120 Huyshope Ave., Suite 401, Hartford, CT 06106 , and to his D.C. office at 136 Hart Senate Office Building, Washington, D.C.20510. ***(Handwritten letters get a lot of attention!!!)*** **Tell him clearly that you are asking him to introduce legislation in the Senate mirroring H.R. 3565, immediately.**

H.R. 3565 is described by the **Center for Constitutional Rights** as “a historic bill that prohibits the transfer and sale of specific U.S. weapons to Israel that the Israeli government has consistently used to commit atrocities against Palestinian civilians in violation of both international and U.S. law. It's a straightforward and necessary challenge to United States complicity in Israel's genocidal campaign in Gaza as Israeli forces block humanitarian assistance and directly target schools, hospitals, and civilians.” See: <https://ccrjustice.org/home/press-center/press-releases/center-constitutional-rights-supports-historic-block-bombs-act>.
