


Resistance to fascism is a light in the darkness



HERE'S SOMETHING YOU CAN DO THIS AFTERNOON: *Back Again! Standout Against Avelo: No Illegal Deportation Flights*



Time: TODAY - Sunday, December 28, 1:30 – 3:30pm EST, Tweed Airport Main Entrance, Fort Hale Road & Burr Street, New Haven.

We say NO to deportation flights without due process. No to profiting off family separation. Join us in demanding Avelo Airlines end its contract with ICE and stop these cruel and dangerous flights immediately.

2025 has been a dark year in human history as rightwing authoritarian governments- most notably our own- have consolidated power throughout the world. But the light of resistance has remained and is growing steadily. Throughout 2025 there have been uprisings everywhere against the imperialist wars, the lies, the corruption, the escalating destruction of our

environment, and the racism, misogyny, cruelties and injustices whose only goal is to enrich and empower a handful of oligarchs and dictators.

Thousands of people are speaking out every day. Millions are on the march all over the world. There is growing institutional and individual non-compliance with the demands of illegitimate governments. Communities throughout the United States are confronting and stopping ICE, Homeland Security, and the use of the military in our cities. Millions are protesting genocidal wars. Human rights are being defended by Black and Brown, LGBTQ+, disabled and poor communities and allies everywhere.

Here are just a few examples of very recent actions by diverse groups:

- **December 20:** Thousands of people in Minneapolis marched more than a mile along the city's Lake Street corridor in a coordinated anti-immigration enforcement protest against the Department of Homeland Security's Operation Metro Surge, now in its third week.
- **December 18:** Hundreds of demonstrators gathered at the Port of Oakland at a public meeting of the port commission to demand an arms embargo on Israel because of the ongoing killing of the people of Gaza. (The city's port is under the same authority as the airport, where U.S. arms are regularly shipped to Israel on FedEx commercial aircraft.)
- **December 13:** About 500 protesters lined the streets of Baltimore outside the M & T stadium where Trump was attending the Army-Navy game.
- **December 7:** Dozens of protesters gathered outside the White House, voicing outrage over the continuing U.S. strikes on Venezuelan boats that Washington claims, with no proof, are involved in drug-trafficking operations- a transparent pretext for a war for control over Venezuela's government and oil resources.
- **There are ongoing actions by many different groups in Washington, DC, declaring the White House a "crime scene" occupied by a lawless, corrupt dictator.**
