On April 20, veterans and military family members protesting the Iran war stood in the rotunda of Cannon House Office Building in Washington, D.C. They held red tulips honoring Iranians killed by U.S. bombs and conducted a flag-folding ceremony symbolizing the U.S. troops killed. Sixty-six protesters were arrested.
